Set up the Amazon Alexa app on your smart device

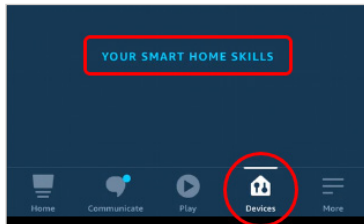
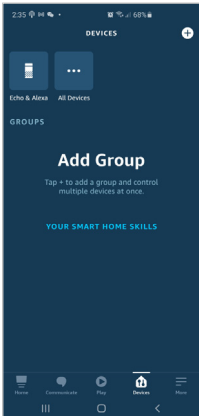
(You can skip this part and jump to Part 2 if you have Amazon Alexa already set up.)

1. Download Amazon Alexa app from the App Store and create an Amazon account.
2. Open the Amazon Alexa app and set up your Amazon speaker within the Amazon Alexa app.

Part 2

Link your KASTA devices to your Amazon Alexa app

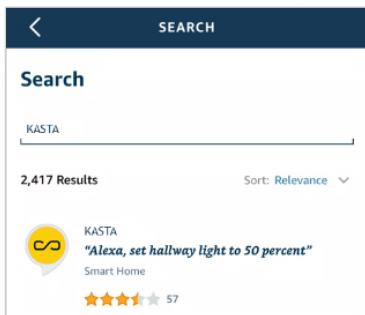
1. Go to the “Devices” page and tap on “Your smart home skills”.



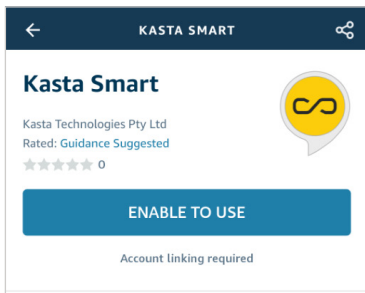
2. Select

ENABLE SMART HOME SKILLS

3. Find the KASTA skill by scrolling down the list or typing “KASTA” into the Search, and then select the KASTA skill.




4. Select “Enable to use”.



5. Fill in the _____ to allow Amazon Alexa to link to your KASTA app. Then select “Link Now”.

Instead of entering a phone number, enter the email address and password you used to create and login to your Kasta account.
